NEW AND OTHER ACTIVITIES

- 23 Sick Newborn Care Unitsare functional in 22 districts.
- Total 120 cold calls have been madedone to staff nurses and doctors through help line number.
- 314 blood samples and environment samples were collected from SNCUs.
- Total 14 facilities were visited in Dantewada for field mentoring
- 44 staff Nurses who are placed at CHC and PHC have been trained by Mentor Nurses in Dantewada.
- Mentor Nurses have visited 32 facilities and trained 192 field staff and 38 ANMs in Bastar, Bijapur and Narayanpur.

STAFF STATUS

- Under the PCA (Program Cooperation Agreement), 23 SNCUs were functional across 22 districts (Raipur, Durg, Dhamtari, Bilaspur, Bijapur, Rajnandgaon, Ambikapur, Jagdalpur, Koriya, Korba, Raigarh, Kanker, Dantewada, Jashpur, Mahasamund and Kawardha, Balod, Balrampur, JanjgirChampa, Sukhma and Kondagaon) providing 24/7 care delivery to the infants.
- All functional SNCUs have adequate number of trained staff nurses and Data entry operators (DEO).
- A total of 282 staff nurses, 23 Doctors and 21 DEOs were placed across these 23 SNCUs.


Status of samples collected from different SNCUs

SUCCESS STORY

A Baby girl, born to Sangeeta (name changed) was a preterm baby with a low birth weight of 1.2kg which is far below from normal weight. She was admitted in SNCU for treatment and was discharged when she was 30 days old with a weight of 1.67 kg. Her ROP first screen, OAE was also done.

The biggest achievement was that the baby was treated without antibiotic.
