






HIGHLIGHTS:


- Under the Program Cooperation Agreement, all the 18 SNCUs across 17 districts provide round the clock care to all sick newborns.
- A total of 208 staff nurses, 23 Doctors and 16 DEOs were working in these sick newborn units.
- In all, 755 medical equipment supplies were inventoried within 18 SNCUs out of which 424 (56%) were covered under the Annual Maintenance Contract or were still under warranty.
- All the SNCUs were provided with the central helpline phone number in order to ensure timely repairs. During this month, the engineers have made 64 preventive visits in SNCUs and FRUs.
- A total of 2 breakdown calls were registered from different districts in March 18.
- In this month, 41 blood samples were collected from all the SNCUs.
- Total 191 cold calls were made to the staff nurses in March 2018 through helpline number.
- Facilitated the FBNC training in March 2018.
