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HIGHLIGHTS


- 19 Sick Newborn Care Units are functional in 18 districts.
- •A total of **145 cold calls** have been made to staff nurses through help line number.
- 5 b**reakdown calls** were received from Raipur, Durg, Dhamtari, Koriya and Raipur Medical College.
- 12 preventive visits in total were made by engineers in SNCUs.
 - 227 blood samples were collected from SNCUs.
 - Total 11 Public Health Centers and 2 Community Health
 Centers were visited in Dantewada.
- 50 Nurses who are placed at CHC and PHC have been trained by Mentor Nurses in Dantewada.
- **Baseline Quality Assessment** competed at 39 PHCs and CHCs in Bastar, Jagdalpur and Narayanpur district in ISHA project.

STAFF STATUS

 In accordance with the PCA (Program Cooperation Agreement), 19 SNCUs were functional across 18 districts (Raipur, Durg, Dhamtari, Bilaspur, Bijapur, Rajnandgaon, Ambikapur, Jagdalpur, Koriya, Korba, Raigarh, Kanker, Dantewada, Jashpur, Mahasamund and Kawardha, Balod and JanjgirChampa) providing 24/7 care delivery to the infants in September2018. All functional SNCUs have adequate number of trained staff nurses and Data entry operators (DEO).

• A total of 211 Staff Nurses; 17 Doctors and 21 Data Entry Operators were placed across these 19 SNCUs.

TOTAL RECRUITED




EQUIPMENT STATUS

- In all, 919 equipment supplies were inventoried within the 18 SNCUs. Around 60%(552) of the equipment was covered under the Annual Maintenance Contract or was still under warranty while around 40 % of the equipment (367) was not under warranty.
- On an average, 98 % of the equipment was functioning. While only 2% of both- the non-warranty and the warranty equipment- was not functional.
- All the SNCUs were provided with the central helpline phone number in order to ensure timely repairs.

During this month, 12 preventive visits have been done by the Bio-Medical Engineers in SNCUs and FRUs (First Referral Units).


