NURSE MENTOR PROGRAM

ISHA PROJECT IN BASTAR, BIJAPUR AND NARAYANPUR SOUTHERN CHHATTISGARH

- Project started in Nov'18
- Total of eight mentor nurses working in three aspirational districts.
- Average facility visits per month are 34.
- Mentoring done for 875 days
- 2478 Mentoring Sessions delivered by Mentor Nurses till June
- 70.8 SNs trained per month on an average



ENVIRONMENTAL MICROBIAL SURVEILLANCE

Ekam has started environmental microbial surveillance of labour room with the collaboration of UNICEF and AIIMS. Project was started in April'19, all over district hospitals of Chhattisgarh. A total of 23 DH were planned and till June 17.



Pre cleaning and post cleaning swabs were collected from various part of hospital from labour room, OT, SNCU, PNC ward, Air sample and sample of disinfectant also collected to test the microorganism. Total of 1537 samples were collected from 17 facilities.



SKILL LAB SETUP

Maternal and child health mini skill lab established in Bastar, Bijapur, Narayanpur district hospital with collaboration of UNICEF.started in Nov'18.

NEONATAL MICROBIAL SURVEILLANCE

Ekam has started Environmental Microbial Surveillance of labour room with the collaboration of UNICEF and AIIMS.

Coordinating with 18 SNCU –District hospital and timely submitting their sample to AIIMS through sample runners.

Many samples are transported through private buses and submitted to AIIMS. Among all the collected samples, **28% were found to be positive.**

SNCU UPGRADATION

Ekam is in partnership with NHM for upgrading the SNCUs of Chhattisgarh through HR recruitment.

- 23 SNCUs are functional in 22 districts of Chhattisgarh.
- 21 data entry operators were recruited and posted in 21 districts.
- 46 % of doctors (MO and PGMO) were recruited and posted in SNCUs of Chhattisgarh.

Along with SNCU, New Born Stabilization Unit is also looked after by Ekam foundation from August.

DANTEWADA HEALTH FACILITY UP-GRADATION PROGRAM

Ekam, in collaboration with the District Collectorate, is working for improving the health facilities of Dantewada district through providing HR, and Nurse mentoring. The Project was started in June' 2017 and has been extended till 2020.

Whats New?

Community mentor nurses:

The objective of the project is to improve the quality of MCH care in the community through providing training in cascade model ANM in sub centres.

Nurse mentoring program:

The objective of the project is to improve the quality of MCH care in the state through providing training in cascade model to field staff nurses placed at CHC and PHC and DH.


Human Resource:


For improving the better services in district hospital 18 staff nurses, 9 Lab technicians, 2 mentor nurses, 1 biomedical engineer will be placed in respective departments.
