


OUR PROGRAMS

Enhancing Infrastructure to Establish Model Labor Rooms

Maternity care is essential for ensuring outcomes for mothers positive and newborns, significantly contributing to babies' cognitive development. We began with a thorough labor ward assessment in four PHCs, initially shortlisting Padappai and Panrutti PHCs, with Vallam PHC joining the initiative in March 2023. At Ekam, we are committed to empowering mothers and communities to become local champions of knowledge. Through various awareness programs on maternal, child, and adolescent care, we strive to promote self-reliance and wellbeing.



In FY 2023-24, EKAM Foundation, in collaboration with the Eicher Group Foundation, undertook initiatives to strengthen community health systems across targeted regions. The project focused on empowering frontline health workers, enhancing maternal and child healthcare services, and addressing pressing healthcare gaps within underprivileged communities.

Key highlights include:

- Capacity-building workshops for healthcare providers.
- Distribution of critical medical supplies to health centers.
- Advocacy and awareness programs on maternal and child health.

This partnership demonstrated the impact collaborative efforts of in fosterina sustainable healthcare improvements and contributed significantly to EKAM's mission of ensuring accessible and quality healthcare for all. The project improved healthcare services, increased community awareness, and established a model for self-sustaining villages, setting а new standard for maternal and child health care.



Manpower Support for Institute of Child Health, Egmore, Chennai – Funded by RK Industries

With the generous funding support from Mr. Ajay Agarwal and Mrs. Garima Agarwal of RK Industries, EKAM Foundation has provided critical manpower support to the Institute of Child Health (ICH), Egmore, Chennai. This initiative has strengthened the hospital's capacity to deliver essential pediatric healthcare services.

A team of eight dedicated professionals, including anesthesia technicians, theater technicians, lab technicians, and specialized nursing staff, have been instrumental in supporting various departments, ensuring quality care for children.

Between 2023 and 2024, this project has positively impacted 39,174 children while also training 2,393 frontline workers, thereby contributing to better healthcare outcomes and capacity building in pediatric care.

This partnership highlights EKAM's commitment to bridging gaps in healthcare delivery through strategic collaborations with organizations like RK Industries.

Strengthening Neonatal Care: Ekam USA's Support for Thoothukudi SNCU

In February-March 2024, Ekam USA generously supported the Government Thoothukudi Medical College Hospital by donating essential medical equipment to strengthen the Special Newborn Care Unit (SNCU). The contribution, which aimed to restore resilience following the December 2023 floods in Thoothukudi District, was acknowledged by the hospital and officially handed over by Dr. Poongothai (Indian Medical Association, Tuticorin OG Society) to Dr. Sivakumar (Dean of the hospital).

This initiative has had a significant impact, enhancing the quality of neonatal care and contributing to the long-term goal of reducing neonatal mortality rates in Tamil Nadu. This collaboration was widely recognized, including in a local press release, showcasing the vital role of partnerships in transforming healthcare for vulnerable children.







Capacity Building

Our capacity building initiatives focus on empowering healthcare providers and community volunteers with the knowledge, skills and tools necessary for effective maternal and child healthcare.

Lactation Game

On August 8th, 2023, Ekam released the Lactation Awareness Game. We emphasize the importance of Social and Behavioral Change Communication to improve child outcomes, focusing on timely initiation and exclusive breastfeeding to reduce neonatal and infant mortality. This educational tool empowers mothers, community workers, and nurses with knowledge about the benefits of breastfeeding through interactive gameplay and informative content.

COMMUNITY INTERVENTIONS

EKAM empowers communities by fostering collaboration, trust, and mutual support. Through health awareness programs, workshops and partnerships with local leaders, we ensure vital health information reaches even the most remote areas. Our community health workers act as bridges, providing essential services and continuous support.

Ekam Foundation has been actively engaged in comprehensive community health assessments in Perumbakkam and Kannagi Nagar. These assessments 1,565 households. surveyed within identifying various health needs the communities. Trained surveyors and focus groups played a crucial role in informing interventions, particularly for safe pregnancies and lactation practices.






Collaboration with local authorities, NGOs, and community organizations maximized resources and involved the community in health policy.

Through this multi-pronged and comprehensive approach, Ekam's Health Model goes beyond providing healthcare services – it empowers communities to take charge of their health and well-being, building a healthier future for generations to come.

Our District Coordinators have been improving the health of high-risk pregnant women, sick newborns & children through maternal & child health awareness and through tracking and follow up of high risk mothers and children.

Rebuilding Community Health and Wellbeing - Health Needs Assessment in Perumbakkam and Kannagi Nagar

From February to March 2024, EKAM Foundation, in partnership with the HCL Foundation, conducted a comprehensive Health Needs Assessment (HNA) in Chennai's resettlement areas of Perumbakkam and Kannagi Nagar. Covering 1,565 households-1,079 in Perumbakkam and 486 in Kannagi Nagar—the survey included both quantitative data collection and qualitative insights from seven Focus Group Discussions and six In-Depth Interviews.

The assessment highlighted critical health issues in these communities. including challenges maternal in health, drug abuse, and limited access to sanitation, with residents also facing health environmental hazards. Findings from this assessment will support the Health System in prioritizing interventions and resources to address these identified needs. This initiative underscores the importance health of targeted services and community engagement to improve well-being in under-resourced areas.

Nurturing Collective Livelihoods – A Path to Empowerment and Resilience emerging from the Neighborhoods of Bangalore and Coimbatore

The "Nurturing Collective Livelihoods" project, a collaboration between EKAM Foundation and BOSCH. addresses economic challenges and inequalities in Bangalore and Coimbatore by building sustainable. inclusive livelihood opportunities. Through a Self-Help Group model, the project promotes microenterprises that foster teamwork, empowerment, and resilience among This marginalized communities. approach social strengthens bonds and enhances participants' economic stability, instilling confidence and self-reliance. The success of this initiative showcases the transformative impact of collaborative efforts, serving as an inspiring model for inclusive development that can be replicated in other regions and sectors. Nutrition Kit Donation Project

In collaboration with key partners, EKAM Foundation successfully implemented the Nutrition Kit Donation Project aimed at addressing malnutrition among vulnerable children and families. Through this initiative, essential nutrition kits were distributed to communities in need, focusing on improving overall health and well-being.

The project highlighted the importance of nutritional support in fostering healthier childhoods and reducing health disparities. This impactful effort aligns with EKAM's mission to ensure accessible healthcare and improved living conditions for underprivileged communities.











Adolescent Empowerment to Prevent Child Marriages



In Chhattisgarh, adolescents (ages 10-19) face significant challenges such as child marriage, child labor, trafficking, teenage pregnancy, and increasing crime rates. To address these issues, the Government of in collaboration with Chhattisgarh, the Department Women Child of and Ekam, Development, UNICEF. and launched a multi-sectoral program focused on adolescent empowerment, aiming to end child marriage and violence against children.

The initiative involved coordinating various departmental schemes to empower adolescents and creating District Action Plans, which were consolidated into a State Action Plan. Capacity development at district, sub-district, and frontline levels was also prioritized to ensure effective service delivery and strengthen platforms for adolescent participation.



Key Achievements

- Established functional task forces in 9 districts to prevent child marriage and violence against children.
- Developed operational work plans in 5 districts.
- Trained 26,154 frontline workers across 1,421 Gram Panchayats.
- Empowered 393,965 adolescents with knowledge on child protection.
- Engaged 28,835 adolescents through volunteer and life skill programs.
- Recruited 12,451 adolescent volunteers.
- Supported 6,440 girls to enroll and/or remain in school.
- Enabled 11,446 adolescents to access protection services and government schemes.
- Provided vocational training and life skills to 89,711 girls.
- Benefited 4,175 girls through social protection schemes.

Kangaroo Mother Care (KMC)

In Tamil Nadu's government hospitals, specifically in the Special Newborn Care Units (SNCUs), EKAM's efforts significantly benefits mothers and infants, providing KMC sling bags, counseling sessions, raising awareness of government schemes and offering newborn care training. These projects effectively achieves its goals.



By partnering with other organizations, EKAM distributed free Kangaroo Mother Care (KMC) sling bags to marginalized families seeking child care in government hospitals.





At the Institute of **Obstetrics** and Gynaecology in Egmore, the initiative has benefited lactating mothers, low-birthweight babies, and sick children. Key outcomes include heightened awareness mothers and their families. among enhanced community practices of Mother Care (KMC), and Kangaroo stronger familial support, all contributing to a reduction in mortality rates.

In Coimbatore, we trained a group of SHG women to professionally stitch Kangaroo Mother Care (KMC) sling bags, connecting them emotionally to their work and empowering them economically.



On World Prematurity Day, we celebrated Kangaroo Mother Care (KMC), a special way to help premature babies grow stronger. Supported by **Dr. Soumya Swaminathan**, former WHO Chief Scientist, KMC is all about keeping babies close to their mothers' skin. This helps them stay warm, feel secure, and get the love and food they need.

Premie Kits for Preterm Babies – Partnered by Future Focus Infotech via Auxohub

In collaboration with Future Focus Infotech Pvt Ltd through Auxohub Consulting, EKAM Foundation successfully distributed 150 Premie Kits to the Department of Neonatology at IOG, Egmore, Chennai. This initiative focused on supporting preterm babies (weighing less than 1.2 kg) admitted to the NICU.

The Premie Kits, provided at the time of discharge, included baby care beds, clothing, and sensory development toys. These resources proved instrumental in ensuring thermal support, comfort, and early sensory stimulation for these vulnerable infants.

This contribution, acknowledged through a letter of appreciation from IOG Egmore, reflects EKAM's continued commitment to neonatal care and our fruitful partnerships with corporate sponsors and consulting agencies to improve healthcare outcomes for newborns in need.

Hemalatha, a mother of two, faced a challenging pregnancy due to severely low hemoglobin levels. She came to us in a state of despair, worried about her health. Our dedicated EKAM team and healthcare workers provided the necessary medical treatment and nutritional support. Through their concerted efforts, Mrs. Hemalatha's hemoglobin levels improved and she was able to give birth to a healthy baby.

"During my second pregnancy, I was scared and worried due to my low hemoglobin levels. But thanks to the unwavering support and care of the Ekam staff, I was able to improve my health and give birth to a healthy baby. They not only treated me but also gave me hope when I needed it the most" This mother's journey began with the birth of her baby, born prematurely and struggling to breathe. Weighing just 800 grams, her baby fought with incredible determination to survive. With the dedication of our doctors and nurses, who provided round-theclock care and support, this tiny fighter gradually doubled her weight to 1.6 kilograms."

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"When my baby was born prematurely, weighing just 800 grams, I was terrified. But thanks to the dedication and care of the doctors and nurses, she fought bravely and grew stronger every day. On March 21st, 2024, we joyfully brought her home. I will forever be grateful for the support we received."

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Culture Positive

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
